Proclamation

WHEREAS, *Medical imaging exams have revolutionized medicine and are directly linked to greater life expectancy for Americans, declines in cancer and hospital mortality rates and are most often safer and less expensive than the invasive procedures they replaced; and*

WHEREAS, *medical imaging scans reduce the number of invasive surgeries, unnecessary hospital admissions and lengths of hospital stays and help lower health care costs for Americans; and*

WHEREAS, *the New England Journal of Medicine has named medical imaging one of the 10 top medical advances of the last 1,000 years; and*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL B. HANCOCK, MAYOR of the City and County of Denver, Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby officially proclaim **NOVEMBER 8, 2012**, to be known as:

“DENVER DAY OF RADIOLOGY”
