



US – presumed panc head mass, dilated thickwalled CBD terminates in "mass"




CT – bulbous panc head – no mass

Delayed CT- subtle delayed enhancement of "capsule"




Dual-Phase CT of Autoimmune Pancreatitis: A Multireader Study


